If you've attended jail meetings before, you know the rules ... no weapons, no cell phones, etc. When entering any correctional facility, we are considered guests and must conduct ourselves accordingly. Volunteer orientation is not required; however, please call Rick R. at 235-6787, or Kerry G. at 350-2935 for more information.

I attended the Southwest Regional Forum October 12-14 in Denver along with 25 or so members of Area 46. Over 800 people attended and it was the largest Southwest Regional Forum ever. One of the sessions was "Our 12th Step Responsibility -- Are We Going to Any Length?" Whenever Volunteer Orientation comes up, I'm reminded that as volunteers we go to any length just to attend meetings in jails and prisons. The opportunity for service at Kirtland AFB is especially attractive since volunteer orientation is not required. Give Rick or Kerry a call ... attend a jail meeting this month.

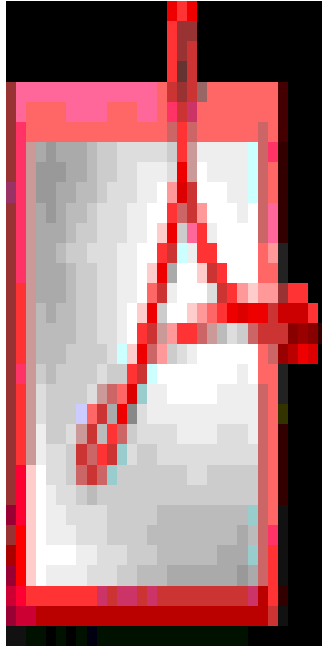
