

Qualifications for Steering Committee membership, duties, and terms of office

- The Steering Committee monitors and supports Central Office operations and makes necessary proposals to Intergroup representatives.
- Any member of Alcoholics Anonymous with experience with the Central Office having at least 2 years of continuous sobriety shall be eligible for office.- Central Office By-laws, Article V, Section 2
- In addition to their other duties, every member is a voting member of the Steering Committee.
- Each member shall attend monthly Steering Committee Meetings at 7:00 PM on the Tuesday prior to the Intergroup Representatives Meeting.
- Steering Committee members shall also attend the Intergroup Representatives Meeting on the second Sunday of each month at 2:00 PM.
- The monthly general Steering Committee meeting is held at St. Mark's on the Mesa Episcopal Church: 431 Richmond Place NE.
- The monthly general Intergroup Representatives meeting is held at the Brownbaggers location: 3939 San Pedro NE, Bldg. F, Suite A
- All steering committee members shall be elected by the Intergroup Representatives for a term of two years, with elections held each year for half of the members ("staggered" terms). Officers shall be eligible for reelection to the same office for one succeeding two-year term.
