# Albuquerque Central Office Treasurer's Report - Narrative February 2024

This was a very good month for Central Office. We are grateful to the Fellowship for your support. The report now contains Year-To-Date (YTD) graphs.



## **Income**

- This was a SENSATIONAL MONTH the fellowship overcame the December shortfall!.
- Other Income is unfortunately inflated by \$489.56 due to my error. I filed Jul 21, 2023 EFTPS payment for \$489.56 as being in Q2 not Q3. The IRS refunded that amount. In March we will be charged for missing that payment in July. I am working with the account to see if we can avoid the \$75 penalties and interest.

Sales of Inventory were strong.

#### **Expenses**

- There is a \$0.02 Other Expense cleaning up accounting from an invoice in 2020 that also appears on the Balance Sheet.
- Payroll is up \$572.38 from last year due to alt coordinator covering coordinator vacation and some extra hours for meetings.
- Balance Sheet Inventory is stable.

## **Cash Position**

- I transferred \$2,000 back to Prudent Reserve from the revenue shortfall in December.
- End of the month cash is \$23,062.97, **\$933.27** more than last month. Our savings account (prudent reserve) is at \$20,281.20.

## Other Items

- Central Office now supports contributions via Venmo! @CentralOfficeABQ.
- ➤ Steve V and I have begun to compile a list of assets / actions to be taken in a disaster scenario and assign some dollars to them. This will be the basis for what are prudent reserve needs to be. Note that I have increased the insurance policy from \$26,000 to \$40,000 due to additional space.
- Our insurance policy has to be updated for use of the 1919 entrance.
